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## Reginning of draft of a letter by Ludwig Wittgenstein to J.M. Heynes about July 1-24

dy dear revnes! Thanks awfully for your books a for your letter dated .....lease excuse me for answering so late. Thy I but of writing to you so long was because I was afraid I should not be able to make myself understood to you in English and if I wrote in perman although the business does not become hopeless at this and in this case already you might not find anybody to translate my letter. But now I thought I would have to try after all a write in anglish. Well: It was very kind indeed of you to write me to stay in angland during the summer. Now the absolute truth about the matter is this: 1) I should like very much to see you again: on the other hand 2.) I'm afraid I shall probably stamppoint you because I have changed so much since we met last. Especially I am no longer capable to do any good
