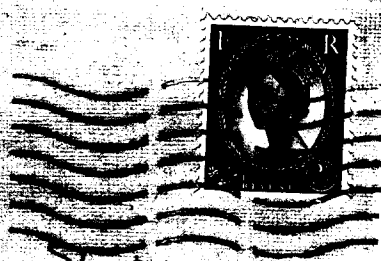

are feeling complete relief after



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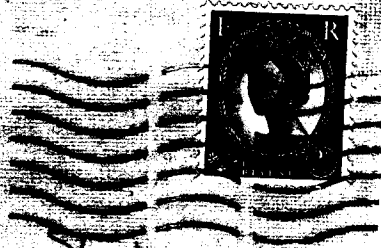
last year's operation, from

expecting my birthday on Thursday



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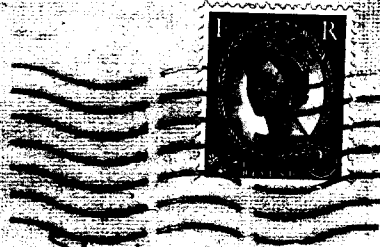
